Offers available are:

Tax-free childcare accounts; 30 hours childcare; Universal Credit childcare; 15 hours childcare for 2 year olds (from April 2024)

From April 2024: 15 hours childcare for eligible working families in England of 2 year olds

- each parent earning under £100K per year and at least £167 per week (equal to 16 hours at the National Minimum or Living Wage)
- with a 2 year old child#
- 15 hours of childcare or early education for 38 weeks
- A total of 570 hours per year, that can be used flexibly with one or more childcare providers

#eligible from the term after the child's 2nd birthday, ie.

child's birthday in September to December = eligible from January

child's birthday in January to March = eligible from April (ie. after Easter)

child's birthday in April to August = eligible from September
