

North Nibley Pre-school Cookie Preferences and Privacy Notice

This cookie policy explains how wix.com use cookies and similar technologies in their services in relation to hosting and supporting North Nibley Pre-school's website (www.northnibleypreschool.co.uk) on their server. It explains what these technologies are and why we use them as well as your rights to control their use.

What are cookies?

Cookies are simple text files that are stored on your computer or mobile device by a website's server. Cookies are created and used via HTTP(S) protocol. They are not malicious by nature and will not invade your privacy. Each cookie is unique to your web browser. Most browsers contain privacy settings, allowing you to review and manage cookie files. Cookies will contain some anonymous information such as a unique identifier, website's domain name, and some digits and numbers.

What types of cookies do we use?

Necessary cookies

Necessary cookies allow us to offer you the best possible experience when accessing and navigating through our website and using its features. For example, they ensure visitor browsing-security by prevent cross-site request forgery.

Analytical cookies

These cookies enable us to understand how visitors interact with our website by collecting and reporting information anonymously. These cookies do not contain personal information such as names and email addresses and are used to help us improve your user experience of the website.

Marketing cookies

Marketing cookies are used to track visitors across websites – the one used on the Pre-school's website is specifically with regards to all wix.com sites. The information collected can be used to make advertisement more relevant to the visitor.

Where are cookies stored?

Cookie files need to be stored somewhere to be able to remember what you did on the website. As such, they are stored directly on your hard drive by your browser. Next time you visit our website, your browser will send saved cookies to our website's server, allowing the server to use the saved information.

How long do cookies last?

The majority of cookies are deleted automatically once you close your browser. However, other cookies may have a specified time of expiry date, but the average lifetime of a cookie is about 30 days.

Who can access and view my cookies?

Only the domain name (ie www.northnibleypreschool.co.uk) that saved the cookies on your hard drive can access and read them. They cannot be accessed or examined by other websites.

Accepting a cookie does not mean that your personal information is in danger or that a cookie can deliver a virus. However, advertising and tracking networks may use cookies to track your visits across the internet.

General Data Protection Regulations (GDPR) 2018/Data Protection Act 2018

The GDPR covers personal data regulations. Any information that can be related to a real, identifiable person is protected and cannot be used without the person's permission (information such as the cookie identifier, IP address, and the device's ID).

To be compliant with these regulations, we display a consent banner to inform visitors about the use of cookies.

How to delete cookies?

If you want to restrict or block the cookies that are set by our website, you can do so through your browser setting. Alternatively, you can visit www.internetcookies.org, which contains comprehensive information on how to do this on a wide variety of browsers and devices. You will find general information about cookies and details on how to delete cookies from your device.
